


ND Tax Incentive: benefits maternity homes

It means you can save up to \$2,500 on your state taxes by making a gift to our Home. Every dollar you give to our maternity home is a dollar you save on your ND income taxes – up to \$2,500 or half the total you owe (whichever is lower).*

Heartfelt Reflections of a Housemother

This June marked my fourth trip back to Warsaw to serve as a Housemother here at the Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Maternity Home. My first visit was the summer before my junior year of college, and I never anticipated that this place would become my home one day. However, after each visit, I always felt a longing to return and after finishing school this past May, I was overjoyed to be able to commit to a full year as a Housemother.

Since I grew up in California and went to school in Indiana, many people were surprised when I told them that I would be moving to North Dakota for a year. Most people would respond by asking, “What is there even in North Dakota?” I always found that simply saying “a Maternity Home” was never enough to convey what I’ve found here. North Dakota, and more specifically the Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Maternity Home, is where I’ve experienced the love of God, and I’ve been able to share it with others in the most profound way.



Working at this Home has given me a chance to grow each day and discover God's presence in every moment. Most days, I find myself completing tasks that might seem menial such as washing bottles, cooking dinner, mopping the floors, changing diapers, and driving residents to appointments.

Other days, I experience things for the first time, such as cooking 40 pounds of ground beef, learning Spanish to communicate with one of our moms, waking up to feed a baby in the middle of the night, or holding the hand of a mother in labor. I have learned that there is great meaning and joy in these moments because I complete them for those I love around me.



While this Home has taught me to give more of myself to others, I've received even more in return through those I have encountered here. The mothers at the Home, each with their own unique gifts and personality, inspire me and bring laughter to my life each day. Even on the more difficult days, I find peace in knowing that the Lord has brought us together here to be a family and take on life's challenges. Chatting with the residents and praying in the chapel with them every evening are the sweetest moments of my day.

Through the Home I've also met so many generous individuals and families who share my great love for the work we do here. The Saint Gianna and Pietro Molla Maternity Home family has welcomed me with great kindness, making me feel even more at home. For this and the countless prayers offered for all of us living here at the Home, I am immensely grateful.

I feel so blessed to be able to spend a whole year at the Home, and I cannot wait to see the many ways God will continue to work in the lives of all who live and work here. ♦
